- Major issues:
 - EPC 2013
 - Considerable volume of correspondence after the last plenary
 - By mid January, still no progress on OA or LR
 - Bureau decided to withdraw sanction.

 - Breitling not getting the results they hoped for... may change strategy.
 - Spent all seed money on 'new events'. Downed tools (allegedly)

 - New OA: Unanimous vote that this MUST be a top priority item reflecting the concern of CASI; FAI should allocate appropriate resources to it ASAP.
 - 4-tier Sport Structure in GS – all a bit messy (eg ABG), referred back to WG.
 - WGS 84 Rule Consequences – See IT WG report.
 - UAVs New WG to review.
 - International Jury Handbook; new version approved.
 - GS – new WG to review whole document
 - Championship records – streamline submission – deferred pending further thought (like how pay fee)

Item 7 - CIMA Bureau report on its activity since the last plenary - *continued*

- Major issues (*continued*):
 - 4-5 October: FAI General Conference, Kuala Lumpur
 - FAI finances a bit fragile. Budget management!
 - Anti-Doping; in-competition testing
 - Could conceivably become an organizer expense at some time in the future.
 - Typically, for 5 pilots in Europe this could cost the organizer EUR 1000
 - Amounts to a surprise expense to an organizer - at the whim of EB.
 - Whatever happens, it will have to be in the OA before it could be implemented.
 - IWGA The World Games 2013, Cali
 - Proposals from NAC Sweden, EB 4 term limit, rolling elections.
 - No statutes amendments allowed.
 - Next general conferences, Bangkok 2014, Rotterdam 2015
 - Most interesting thing was the new voting system.

- 45 aircraft, 78 competitors from 11 nations.
- Jury President: *It was felt that overall the competition was held in good spirit with numerous tight results. The organization worked extremely hard to make the championship the success it undoubtedly was.*

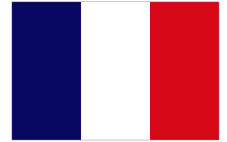

S10 3.17.2 Championship records for Microlights and Paramotors can only be established during valid competition tasks by bona-fide competitors at a FAI ~~category 1~~ Microlight or Paramotor championship **where a CIMA appointed international jury is present**, or a FAI World Air Games.

If the above text is approved, then:

- The Plenary agrees this can apply retrospectively to the two record claims in question.

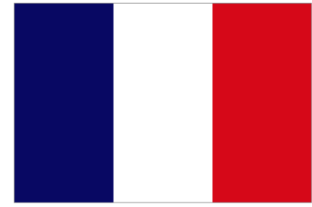
