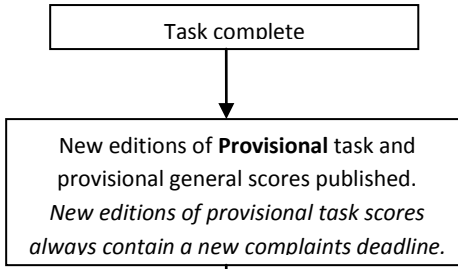
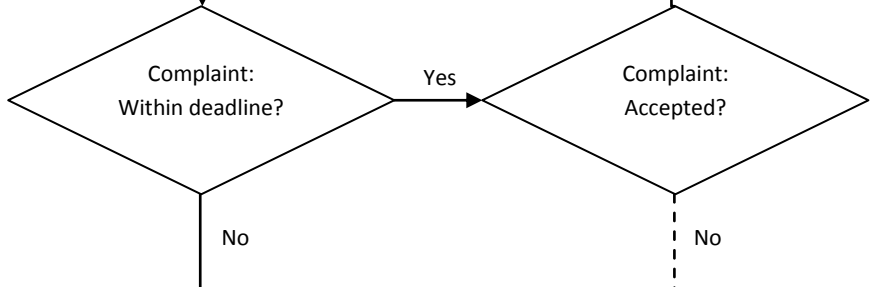


Flow chart illustrating deadlines for complaints and protests in the Powered Paraglider competition at 4 ABG



Complaints deadline for task: 12 hours or time remaining to medals ceremony / 2 - whichever less

Complaints are handled by the competition director. They must be in writing. The response must also be in writing (accepted or denied) plus the reason, and both should be published.



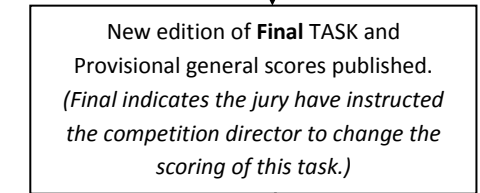
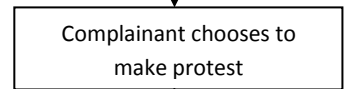
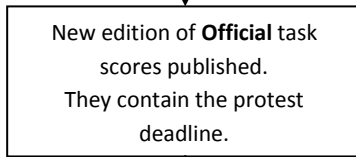
Complaints deadline for task passes
Task scores automatically become official
Protest deadline for task starts: 12 hours or time remaining to medals ceremony / 2 - whichever less

Protests are submitted to the competition director who forwards them to the Jury for investigation. They must:

- Be in writing.
- Be a consequence of a denied complaint.
- Be accompanied by the appropriate fee.

The full formal procedure is contained in FAI Sporting Code.

If there is more than one protest in a task they will all be dealt with before instruction is given to alter scores.



Protest deadline for task passes - Task scores become unalterable by any means.

Protest deadlines for all tasks pass.

New editions of **Official** general scores published; medals can be awarded.
