

# LOC Obligations

- Pay sanction fee
- Athletes/Teams (during competition)
  - Cover all in-country cost (hotel, meals, local transport)
  - 2\*, 3\* Hotel
  - 50% discount for private stays before/after event(s)
- FAI Officials/ -HONs, Staff (during competition)
  - Cover all in-country cost (hotel, meals, local transport)
  - 3\*, 4\* Hotel
  - 50% of transport (except HONs)

# LOC Obligations (cntd.)

- On-site technical/organizational costs
- Run Operational part of competitions
  - Under supervision of FAI
  - In Accordance with FAI guidelines and rules
- 10% of WAG branding space for FAI non-commercial branding
- Media
  - Providing television signal
  - National promotion of WAG
  - Cooperation with FAI to maximize media coverage
