



Hungarian bid for the
14th FAI European Microlight Championship

In cooperation with the Hungarian Aeronautical Association (NAC), the Hungarian Microlight Association is submitting the bid for the 14th FAI European Microlight Championship as follows.

Location:

The event will be hosted in Nagykanizsa Airfield, SW part of the country close to the border with Croatia. 1000 m x 100 m grass runway. The airfield is 3 km far from the city center.





Nagykanizsa and the surrounding area offers great tourist, sightseeing and family attractions. Lake Balaton and famous Hungarian spas are a short car ride away.

No visa needed to enter the country.

Facilities:

We offer to organize challenging tasks, fast and efficient scoring and reliable facilities on site.

Most of the facilities (bathrooms, showers, etc) are already in place and in great condition. High speed internet will be provided during the event.

Camping area will be determined at the airfield. Hotels are available nearby at reasonable prices.

Proposed dates of the event:

- Training days: 9th -11th August 2017
- Opening Ceremony: 12th August 2017
- Competition days: 12th-19th August 2017
- Closing Ceremony: 19th August 2017

Organizing team:

We have a team of officials and marshals already trained for Category 1 event conditions who are aware of possible obstacles during an event and are continuously working on improving their skills.

The position of Competition Director would be occupied by Vince FERINC who in the last over 20 years did not miss any FAI Cat 1 Microlight Championship. He has great experience in both competitor and organizer position, he was the competition director of the WMC 2014. Last year he started to fly gyros and became World Champion in this new category.

Erzsébet VIZAKNAI will serve as Deputy Championship Director. She organized various national and international competitions in different airports (microlights, gliders, hot air ballons, etc) and participated at Category 1 events as team leader, steward and deputy competition director (WMC2014), works for the Hungarian NAC. Also she is active within FAI.

Péter CSUHA will be in charge of Scoring. He is a young and talented engineer with expertise in computer sciences. He is an active pilot. Participated in competitions as team leaders assistant and event organizer in WMC WPC 2014. He is familiar with the tasks and the scoring program.

The Event Director will be Zoltán Gál. He is the chief at Nagykanizsa Airfield for the last few years. He is in charge with daily operations, knows all the aspects of venue management. He is also a microlight pilot.

The duties of the Chief Marshal will be accomplished by Péter Ferinc who assumed a similar position during the World Paramotor Championship in 2014 and at many national and international microlight events.

We are confident that this team will be the key of the success of the event.

In case of emergency:

- hospitals are less than 10 km far from the airport.
- the Event Director will be in charge to coordinate with local authorities, he will alert the safe and rescue teams if necessary

Entry fee:

- 450 EUR for competitors
- 150 EUR for team leaders
- 50 EUR for accompanying persons
