Navigation / estimated speed

Objective

Before takeoff pilots will have declared an estimated time of arrival back at a landing marker in the deck. (The 4m x 4m squares).

Thereafter pilots are free to collect as many photographic turnpoints as detailed below and return to the deck. After landing, pilots must immediately complete the declaration sheet & hand in their films.

Special rules

The value of T is 1 point per second

Pilots who land inside the deck but do not make a first touch inside a landing marker or fall over as a result of the landing: T = T - 20%

Scoring

Pilot score =
$$\left(700 \text{ x } \frac{\text{NBp}}{\text{NBmax}}\right) + (300 - \text{T})$$

Where:

NBp = The number of ground markers and/or turn points a pilot collects in the task<math>NBmax = The maximum number of markers and/or turn points collected in the task T = The total difference in between pilot's estimated and actual time of arrival (>=300 = 300)

Turnpoints

The photo sector for all turnpoints is directly back to Aydin airfield +/ - 20 deg.

Gates

(PPG Local regulations 6.1)

A gate is an imaginary goal post 100 m wide and 500 ft high through which aircraft have to pass. In this task the marshal's job is to record the identity of each aircraft which successfully passes through the gate, and the exact time. The pilots do not necessarily know the exact location of these gates.

Gate marshal duty times

Synchronise watches before departure to positions

Duty time: 07:30 to 09:30

All gates must be in position for the entire duration of the task. These gates must be attended for the entire duration of the task.

Description, Location & personnel

1. Swimming pool, Tatay Hotel

Equipment needed:

Competitor check sheet. (Competitor No./ Name / Time of passage / Successful or failed / reason for failure) Competitor ID photo set

Procedure

- 1. These gates are "hidden" to competitors so please be sure you and your transport are not easily visible from the air.
- 2. The gates are 100m wide and 500 ft high
- 3. Times should be taken in H:M:S on your synchronised watch.
- 4. Record the time and successful passage of all competitors through each gate.
- 5. Record the time and failed passage of all other competitors, and reason for failed passage. E.g. Too high, East of gate Etc.)
- 6. IT IS VITAL TO THE COMPETITION THAT BEFORE THE START OF THE TASK EACH GATE IS IN POSITION & IS POSITIONED AND ALIGNED EXACTLY AS BRIEFED, AND IS NOT REMOVED BEFORE THE END OF THE TASK WINDOW.
- 7. As soon as possible after the close of the task window, hand in your Competitor check list to scoring control.
