



Flight Rules and No-Fly Zones

Basic flight rules

Spanish CAA imposes the following general limitations:

- An altitude limitation of 300 m (1000 ft) AGL for microlights (including paramotors).
- It is forbidden to fly above populated places and groups of people.

Specific instructions will be given for fuel-limited tasks where pilots may use thermals to gain higher altitude.

No-Fly Zones

Chozas airfield is near León ATZ. It is forbidden to fly in a 5 NM circle around León Airport.
