TASK 2

• This task is as task 3.B3 in the local regulations

• Limited fuel; 6 litres.

Photography required

• Briefing: 18:00, Friday 22 June 2001 at Beas de Segura

Official map; 1:50:000 Cordoba.

Takeoff window: 07:00 – 08:00, 24June 2001

• Task closes: 3 ½ hours after window open. Land after task closes: Zero score.

ECONOMY & NAVIGATION

Objective

To take off with a given quantity of fuel and locate an unknown number of markers within defined sectors and return to the deck.

Description

Pilot takes off and departs to the north. The entry and exit gate to the flight sector is turnpoint 5 so the first and last in-flight photos MUST be the canal / road / swimming pool at turnpoint 5. From that point onwards the pilot may choose any number of turnpoints in any order in the flight sector, but he may visit each one only once.

Special rules

- Outlanding: Score zero.
- Failure to have turnpoint 5 as either first or last photo: Score zero.
- To keep clear of the Precision & rally flying championships at Cordoba airport, pilots must not fly any further west than the airfield nor fly above 150m AGL between the airfield and point 5.
- The flight sector is: Guadalquivir river to north, edge of map to east and south, national road 432 to south-west, no flying directly over the city of Cordoba. The sector boundary will be patrolled.
 Penalty for leaving the sector: Zero score.
- Pilots must hand in their digital cameras, secondary films and declaration sheets as soon as possible after landing.

Scoring

Pilot score =
$$1000 \times \frac{NBp}{NBmax}$$

Where:

NBp = The number of ground markers and/or turn points a pilot collects in the task NBmax = The maximum number of markers and/or turn points collected in the task
