3) Regulatory and legal issues Changes to law or regulations

Pilots of aircrafts UL70 and UL115 does need a licence, sufficient is a confirmation of airspace knowledge. However, paragliders, hang gliders, paramotors, and moto-trikes are excluded form the range.

Classification of paramotor has been amended that it is up to 300 kg MTOW (PPGG). Above 300 kg MTOW it is a para plan. Para plans fall under the scope of regular microlights, which is 450 kg MTOW + 22,5 kg BRS.

Microlights: 450 + 22,5 kg BRS
