1) Introduction

Overview of activity since the last plenary meeting

The national Microlight Championships 2020 was held in EYBA(2020-06-20), EYVP(2020-07-18) and EYIG (2020-08-15) airfields. Pilots from RA and RW classes, with total of 26 participants (19 for RA, 7 for RW).

PPG pilots had national competition event in Rokiskis, Lithuania (12 participants) on OCT 12, 2020

2) Sport in your country in 2020

FAI CIMA records: No official record attempts.

3) Regulatory and legal issues

- Due to regulatory structure change, significant additional effort is required to ensure pilot licensing will be in federation.
- Microlight is still defined as per basic regulation annex 1.
- No efforts are given towards 600 kg aeroplanes/gliders/helicopters. Autogyros are 600 kg.

4) Statistics

1057 microlight licenses issued today.

Fully active (all records - up to date) ~700 pilots (airplanes, trikes, paramotors and autogyros).

New licenses issued: 2019 (63), 2020 (75).

Student registrations: 2019 (89), 2020 (93).

*Number of microlight aircrafts: **201 (out of 841)***

5) Any other comments

Changes in air-law: permission is not required for EU-registered annex-1 aircraft entry (it was never enforced and no organization properly issued the permissions).
