Suggestion to change the rules for submitting complaints and protests during the championships, arranged in item 4.35.2 and 4.36.2 of Fai Section 10, 2020, for the purpose of reducing the time available, as both WPC2018 and WPC2022, we identified That the wide deadlines and successive resources are significantly delaying the publication of official results, so we suggest in debate to reduce the deadlines, especially on the last day of proof, so that the award can occur within the period provided for by the organization.
