

CIMA Bureau decision 12 February 2024

<u>Paramotor Slalom Championships – time windows for complaints and protests.</u>

Reference: Section 10, para. 4.35 and 4.36.

On the last day of CIMA championships, the time windows for complaints and protests are 2 hours.

In order to successfully complete the Final Rounds of paramotor slalom championships, the windows for complaints and protests must be shorter.

CIMA Bureau has considered the issue and has decided to reduce the time window to ten minutes for complaints and ten minutes for protests.

Section 10 para 4.35 and 4.36 will therefore be amended to read: (new text)

4.35.2 Complaints must be presented not later than 6 hours after the respective provisional score sheet has been published, not counting the time between 22:00 and 07:00, except for the tasks for which the results are published on the last competition day, or for provisional score sheets published on or after the last competition day, when the time limit is 2 hours, except for paramotor slalom championships during the 'Final Rounds' when the time limit is 10 minutes.

4.36.2 A protest must be presented not later than 6 hours after the respective official score sheet has been published, except for the tasks of the last competition day, or for official score sheets published on or after the last competition day, when the time limit is 2 hours, except for paramotor slalom championships during the 'Final Rounds' when the time limit is 10 minutes. The night time between 22:00 and 07:00 is never included.
