- **2. Registration Opens on 1**st **February**: Downloadable from the Wmc2024.com website (XLS file) template which is filled out by Team Leader with names, type, class, speed, any medical conditions, logger type, etc

For organisational reasons we will be requesting information on T shirts and Camping also.

31st MAY deadline for entry fee to be paid.

£500 for each co-pilot or navigator **before the 31st May** and £550 after this date £75 for each Team Leaders and accompanying persons.
